Dear Friends,

I hope that you are well and have been able to enjoy the glorious autumn colours! I've been reflecting recently on the impact of small consistent actions. In the past I've tended to think that the key to human flourishing or individual "success" is down to making maybe a few big, strategic decisions. But increasingly I'm realising that consistency rather than intensity is the secret sauce. As a friend said to me recently: "we tend to over estimate what we can do in three years and underestimate what we can do in ten years." I think this is also true in relation to faith. For instance, just 10% of religiously observant people say they have no close friends, but the share almost doubles for those who have no faith. Participation in weekly church services also correlates with better health outcomes (American Journal of Epidemiology 2022). Religious participation has also been consistently linked with living longer lives, greater financial generosity and more stable families

There are plenty of opportunities across the Benefice to connect with God and others, keep an eye out for our Remembrance services in particular and also our regular Sunday services. You would be so warmly welcome.
